To you, I lift up my soul, O my God Ps 24


As Advent begins we climb the mountain of the Lord. To receive fresh encouragement and new vision.

Darkness


In the darkness of the night may I have the courage to turn to the Lord.

Wisdom of the Most High, ordering all things with strength and gentleness, come and teach us the way of truth


Gentleness is a disposition that enriches us. It allows us to flourish and others to grow. May it be a gift of this Advent season.


